The Vasa Museum

The royal warship Vasa was launched on 10 August 1628 and sank the same day on its maiden voyage. The ship was salvaged in 1961 and is exhibited in a separate museum.

Open tours in English every day at 10.30, 11.30, 12.30, 13.30, 14.30 and 15.30 included in the entrance fee (230 SEK approx. 17 GBP). NB, Closed on September 17.
